DRAFT MCC REGISTRATION AND FEES POLICY 2015-2016

Policy Statement:

All players who wish to play for Moorebank Cricket Club must be registered and financial before the commencement of each season.

Implementation of the Policy:

1) Prerequisites for Registration

- a) Application for player registration with MCC shall be made via on-line processes at the discretion and direction of the Committee.
- b) Players will not be registered until payment is received.
- c) Players shall not be permitted to play until payment is received and registration information and processes complete.

2) Registration Timetable

- a) Registration shall commence within a reasonable time prior to the season commencing.
- b) Registration shall close prior to the commencement of the relevant season unless otherwise directed by the MCC Committee.

3) Registration Fees

- a) Registration fees shall be set by the Committee and reviewed each year prior to the registration period.
- b) Should a family seek special consideration (in respect of payment of a registration fee) where personal financial hardship or other special circumstances exist, contact with the President needs to be made at the time of registration and/or prior to Week 1 of the season. The President, in consultation with the Treasurer, has the discretion to determine payment plans and their terms on a case by case basis. Such applications will be treated in strictest confidence.
- c) Discounts may be offered for multiple player registration from one family. Discounts shall be determined by the Committee at the time of registration review.
- d) Categories/Discounts
 - i) All seniors with exception of life members, coaches of junior team without a family member in the team pay the senior fee
 - ii) Junior sibling discount of \$20 for each and subsequent after the first fully paid registration.
 - iii) Registered juniors that also play seniors, pay the difference between the junior registration fee and the senior fee if they affiliate as a senior.

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- iv) All minis are to pay set fee with no further discounts.
- v) Pro-rata registration. If registration is completed in the first half of the season 100% and the second half of the season 50% of fees are to be paid.
- vi) Part-time registration (seniors) – 4 matches 50%.
- vii) Juniors not playing for Moorebank as a junior but playing as affiliated as senior for Moorebank will pay the junior fee
- viii) Each senior team can register two emergency players who can be non-financial and can play up to 2 games. Any additional games and associated costs must be approved by the committee.

4) Commencement of season

- a) The Manager/Coach will check all players are eligible to commence playing from the membership list provided by the Committee. Players who have not registered and/or paid will be referred to the Secretary who will arrange for them to complete a registration form immediately and contact the Treasurer and make them aware of fees payable.

5) Parent involvement

- a) As well as a financial commitment to MCC, each family (for each team member) must be willing to assist in coaching, scoring, fundraising activities or other support roles when advised by the team manager.
- b) Training is an important process and players must have attended at least one training session in the week prior before taking part in a fixtures game.
- c) It is the player's/parent's/guardian's responsibility to inform the Coach/Manager if they are unable to attend training or a game.
- d) Players under the age of 16 years are to be accompanied by a parent /guardian at all times. Parents must speak directly with the Coach/Manager before leaving a training session or game, even if it has been completed. This is to ensure the safety of players.

6) Refunds

- a) All requests for refunds of registration fee(s) paid must be in writing and addressed to the Secretary
- b) The Committee will consider each written request for a refund and determine (in its sole and absolute discretion) whether the requested refund or part refund will be granted.
- c) Without limiting the Committee's discretion to determine otherwise, no refunds will be granted or paid:
 - i) where MCC has incurred, or is liable to pay any costs and expenses, for which income from registration fees was to be applied; or
 - ii) once the season to which the requested refund relates has commenced.
